ITERNITY DETAILS

Day 1: Arrival in Nepalgunj

Meet at Hotel in Hotel Diamond Palace Nepalgunj.

Nepalgunj, a bustling town in southwestern Nepal, serves as the gateway to the journey. Take some time to relax and adjust to the higher altitude (around 150 meters).

After dinner our guide will brief you about the entire "Yatra".

Day 2: Flight to Simikot and Acclimatization



After breakfast, transfer to Nepalgunj Airport for a short flight to Simikot, a remote town nestled in the Himalayas (around 2,910 meters Northwest).

Upon arrival in Simikot, you will be transferred to "Bijaya Hotel".

Simikot is a crucial stop for acclimatization to the high altitude before venturing further. Spend the day exploring the local market or simply relaxing to prepare your body for the challenges ahead.

Day 3: Helicopter Transfer to Hilsa (boarder) and drive to Taklakot (Tibet)



Set off on a scenic helicopter ride from Simikot to Hilsa, a small town in Nepal-Tibet border. (around 3,200 meters).

After landing in Hilsa, guides will help to complete immigration formalities and obtain any necessary permits. You will then be transferred to "Himalayan Hotel" in Taklakot.

Taklakot, a frontier town at an altitude of around 3,800 meters, serves as the base for exploring the sacred sites.

Day 4: Spiritual Significance and Exploration



This day is dedicated to experiencing the profound spiritual significance of the Kailash Mansarovar region.

In the morning, drive to the sacred Lake Manasarovar (around 4,580 meters) for a self holy puja (prayer ceremony) and a purifying bath in the icy waters.

Explore the Mansarovar Parikrama, a 72-kilometer circumambulation of the lake, considered a sacred ritual.

Drive to Darchen (around 4,650 meters) and Proceed to Yamadwar (meaning "Gate of Death") for another puja and a glimpse of the majestic Mount Kailash (around 6,714 meters).

Finally, return to Taklakot for the night.

Day 5: Return Journey to Simikot





After breakfast, depart from Taklakot and drive back to Hilsa.

Board a helicopter flight from Hilsa to Simikot, retracing your aerial path from Day 3.

Check in to "Bijaya Hotel" in Simikot for a night's rest.

Day 6: Departure from Simikot to Nepalgunj



On the final day, enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to Simikot Airport for your flight back to Nepalgunj.

Upon arrival in Nepalgunj, your Kailash Mansarovar Yatra concludes.

(You can either connect to onward flights back home or spend some additional time exploring the town)

Nepali Vegetarian three Meals (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) during the trip.

First Aid Medicine Box, oxy-meter and Emergency Oxygen for safety.

Airfare Scheduled flight Nepalgunj – Simikot – Nepalgunj

Charter helicopter flight sharing by 5 people Simikot – Hilsa–Simikot.

The package includes basic travel insurance with the following limits: Medical - 5 Lakh NPR, Accidental Death - 10 Lakh NPR, Heli-rescue via Simrik Air from Nepal border only (with a recommendation from a health post/hospital required in case of a medical emergency).

Excludes:

Airfare Scheduled flight or Overland transportation cost Kathmandu – Nepalgunj – Kathmandu

Domestic excess baggage charges more than stipulated by domestic airlines should be paid extra.

Single Supplement at any hotel.

All beverages, Stick and a water bottle.

Any extra cost incurred due to unforeseen events or weather conditions such as landslide, flight cancellation, strikes, Road blockage and extra nights hotel accommodation bills etc.

Personal expenses such as Photography charges, telephone calls, Hot shower, laundry, any soft/hard drinks, shopping, tipping etc.

Booking & Payments

Trip booking should be done in advance of One (01) month.

Trip booking confirmation should be completed by sending a scan copy of the client's color passport.

A minimum of 6 months of valid passport from the date of departure is necessary.

25 days prior to the tour departure date, 50% of the total cost should be paid in Advance.

Full payment should be made 15 days before departure for the Kailash Mansarovar Yatra.

Tour Cancellation Policy

All notices of cancellation must be sent to our office in writing.

10 days before trip departure: 90% of total trip cost.

Verbal cancellations will not be entertained.

07 days and less departure: 100% of total trip cost.

25 days before trip departure: 30% of total trip cost.

Tour Operators have the full right to change the dates and cancel the trip due to any unavoidable circumstances.

15 days before trip departure: 50% of total trip cost.
